This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to the petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.198 dated 28.11.2013 under Sections 15/25 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Ghall Khurd.

Learned State counsel on instructions from H.C. Gurdarshan Singh submits that only four witnesses remain to be examined. Prosecution shall endeavour to examine them on the next date of hearing i.e. 29.05.2015.

As the trial appears to be nearing its culmination, no ground for enlarging the petitioner on bail is made out. However, a fresh right will accrue to him to seek bail in case trial does not conclude within a period of four months.
