This petition has been moved by Bharpoor Singh under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.68 dated 22.5.2014 registered under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC (offence under Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Rama, Bathinda.

Petitioner is in custody since 25.11.2014. Charge-sheet has been put in Court but charges have not been drawn up.

As per the FIR dated 22.5.2014, the incident took place on 18.5.2014. There was a delay of four days in lodging the FIR.

Medico legal report of the petitioner is also on record and one of the injuries was bone deep lacerated wound of considerable size on right side of his head.

State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Budh Singh, Police Station Rama, submits that there is a compromise deed on the police file. The document is signed/ thumb marked by the complainant and signed by Ranvir Singh and also signed by many persons from the village including the Sarpanch.

Though the authenticity of the compromise is not known at this stage, the fact remains that the petitioner was also injured and there was considerable delay in lodging the FIR. Bail to the satisfaction of trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
