Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Savitari, wife of Balak Ram, Giano wife of Gurmeet Singh and Chindo wife of Amrik Singh, who have been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 302, 323, 148, 149 IPC, later on 302 IPC was substituted by Section 304 IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 98, dated 07.11.2014, registered at Police Station, Ghanaur, District-Patiala.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Baljit Singh submits that pursuant to the order dated March, 18, 2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the aforesaid assertion, interim order dated

March, 18, 2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and shall abide the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is disposed of.

It is made clear that nothing observed herein shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the learned trial court shall consider the case on the basis of evidence and material as produced before it.
