MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for release of the petitioner on bail in terms thereof in a case registered vide FIR No.21 dated 2.5.2012 under Sections 406, 498-A, 420 and 34 IPC at Police Station Dorngla, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the dispute has arisen out of a marital discord and the petitioner is sister-in-law of the complainant.

Noticing this, the Court had granted the interim protection to the petitioner on 18.3.2015, pursuant to which she has since joined the investigation which fact is not controverted by the learned counsel appearing for the State.

Mr. Handa states that the matter now has been settled inter se between the parties and proceedings under Sections 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act initiated which are fixed for 1.12.2015.

If that is so, then I am of the view that the interim directions already granted on 18.3.2015 deserve to be made absolute. Accordingly, the same are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
