Status report by way of affidavit of Amandeep Singh Brar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Amritsar, on behalf of respondents-State, filed in Court is taken on record.

Petitioner seeks regular bail under in FIR No.28 dated 05.02.2015 registered under Sections 21, 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the alleged recovery of 50 grams of heroin is non-commercial in nature. Petitioner was apprehended solely on the basis of suspicion.

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Learned D.A.G. Punjab, on instructions from HC Tejinder Singh states that the petitioner was also involved in FIR No.69 dated 26.04.2010, under Sections 395, 347, 506 IPC, Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar City and in FIR No.35 dated 26.01.2013, under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act, Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran, in which he has already been granted bail.

Be that as it may.

The petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
