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**JASPAL SINGH, J.**

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.193, dated 30.12.2014, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, further enhanced under Section 307 IPC, registered at Police Station Maur and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without undue influence, pressure and coercion. The compromise is genuine and are not the result of

any pressure or coercion in any manner. No other case is pending against either of the parties. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

**3.** In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

**4.** Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.193, dated 30.12.2014, under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, further enhanced under Section 307 IPC, registered at Police Station Maur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
