FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 28.04.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hisar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Aasma Nalwa Tumber and the accused namely Vikram Tumber, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure matrimonial dispute together with the fact that compromise will go

a long way in ironing out differences for the betterment of their future lives, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.710 dated 03.06.2013 registered at Police Station Hisar City, District Hisar under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 506 IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
