The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of First Information Report No.185 dated 29.10.2013 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the ground of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Submissions made by Mr.Rahul Rampal, Advocate representing the petitioners, Mr.AS Klar, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab and Mr.Gagandeep S.Birgi, Counsel for respondent No.2-complainant have been heard.

In pursuance of the order dated 18.3.2015 passed by this Court, learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib has

sent his report with regard to the genuineness of the compromise Annexure P-1. In his report, he has stated that the statements of complainant Gurmanreet Singh and the accused- petitioners have been recorded and the compromise arrived at between the parties apparently appears to be genuine, voluntarily and without there being any sort of pressure or coercion from any corner. Copies of the statements of the parties are attached with the report.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2-complainant has conceded the factum of compromise and submitted that the complainant has no objection, if the First Information Report in question is quashed.

In view of the above, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served in continuing the proceedings. In view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others, (2012)10 SCC 303**, the Court is competent to quash the proceedings on the basis of compromise. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and First Information Report No.185 dated 29.10.2013(Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 341, 323, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
