MAHESH GROVER, J.

This order will dispose of two petitions bearing CRM No.M-877 and 342 of 2015.

The petitioners in both the petitions pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR no.319 dated 24.10.2014 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Farrukhnagar, Gurgaon.

The petitioners faced allegations of having caused injuries inviting the violation of provisions of Section 323 and 325 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that Sections 452 and 506 IPC have been added to aggravate the list of offences to incorporate non-bailable offences. Further contends that pursuant to the orders dated 7.1.2015 (in CRM no.M-342 of 2015) and 15.1.2015 (in CRM no.M-877 of 2015) of this Court, they have joined the investigation which fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the State of Punjab.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts when the petitioners have joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and also noticing the fact that the dispute is inter se between the neighbours and further noticing the fact that no specific role has been attributed to any of the incumbents by name except to refer to all the assailants as the ones who caused injuries, instant petitions are accepted and orders dated 7.1.2015 (in CRM no.M-342 of 2015) and 15.1.2015 (in CRM no.M-877 of 2015) are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
