Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 14, dated 30.01.2015, under Sections 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and 420, 120-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar Rural.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 31.03.2015 directed that in the even of arrest, petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with abovesaid case FIR.
