Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.118 dated 28.6.2013 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P1).

Vide order dated 31.3.2015, this Court has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining the investigation and compliance of provisions of Section 438(2) CrPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 31.3.2015 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid factual position and submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 31.3.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
