Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 76 dated 16.07.2014, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

Mr. S.K. Daaria, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 2 and filed power of attorney.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the land has been transferred in the name of the complainant. He further states that pursuant to order dated 31.03.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 31.03.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
