Petitioner seeks bail pending trial in FIR No.20 dated 8.2.2014 registered under Sections 382, 397, 365, 473 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Daljeet Singh Virk, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, whereas Mr.Rajnish Bansal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is inside the jail for the last about 10 months. He further submits that since only charge has been framed, conclusion of trial will take long time. He prays for allowing the present petition.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jagir Singh, Police Station, Mataur, District SAS Nagar, submits that petitioner has been found involved in as many as nine other FIRs, because of which he is not entitled for bail pending trial. He prays for dismissal of the petition.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and after careful perusal of the record of the case, this Court is of the considered opinion that since the petitioner has been found involved in nine other FIRs, he is not entitled for bail pending trial.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
