Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.92 dated 17.12.2012, under Section 306/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudhrian, District Kapurthala.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from Head Constable Nirmal Singh submits that this is fourth petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail; statements of the petitioners under

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Section 313 Cr.P.C. have been recorded and the case is at the fag end.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute these facts and also states that he wants to lead evidence in defence.

Keeping in view the fact that this is fourth petition and trial is at the fag end, no ground for regular bail to the petitioners is made out.

Dismissed.

However, trial Court is directed to decide the case expeditiously.
