This application has been filed for grant of the regular bail by applicant Ramesh, who was arrested in case on 27.10.2014 and since then he is in custody.

As per the prosecution allegation, the present petitioner and his co-accused caused injuries to complainant Narender and his nephew Surender. The allegations against the petitioner are that he was armed with a Lathi and caused injuries on the waist and neck of complainant Narender. It has not been disputed that those injuries were simple in nature. It has been stated at Bar that injuries No.3, 4 and 5, which have been declared dangerous to life, were suffered by Surneder, the nephew of the complainant. There is no allegation that present petitioner has

caused any injury to Surender. The petitioner is in custody for the last about five months. The trial is not likely to be concluded soon, as it is still pending at the stage of the prosecution evidence. So, the petitioner deserves the concession of bail.

Consequently, the present petition is hereby allowed. Petitioner Ramesh is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panipat.
