Prayer in the instant petition is for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also to respondents No.4 to 5 not to interfere in their personal life and liberty in any manner.

Reply by way of affidavit of Promod Ban, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has been filed by the State.

Learned State counsel submits that as per reply, FIR has been registered against petitioners. Learned State counsel further submits that officials of the police have contacted parents of petitioner No.2 and there is no threat perception to her life and

liberty.

Therefore, no further indulgence of this Court is required. The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the threat perception, if any, upon petitioners filing of fresh representation for future and take appropriate steps if required in accordance with law.

The petitioners who are presently in Protection Home, Ludhiana be immediately produced before the CJM, Ludhiana who will record statement of petitioner No.2 and thereafter release the petitioners from Protection Home.

In case any request is made before the CJM, Ludhiana by respondents No.4 and 5, the CJM would permit meeting of respondents No.4 and 5 with petitioner No.2 in the Mediation Centre of Ludhiana.

Both the petitioners be produced before the CJM, Ludhiana for the aforesaid proceedings on 22.04.2015.

The protection order earlier passed by this Court will be without prejudice to the proceedings in the complaint/FIR registered against petitioners relating to any other offence(s) also.

Registry to immediately Fax the order to the CJM, Ludhiana.

Let copy of this order be given to learned State counsel under signatures of Court Secretary of this Court for compliance.
