Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 286, dated 07.11.2014, for offence Punishable under Sections 498-A, 506, 323 and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sector-31, Faridabad.

This Court, vide order dated 01.04.2015, has granted the ad-interim bail to the petitioner and further directed to him to join investigation on 08.04.2015 at 11:00 A.M.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 01.04.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI-Gurcharan Singh, does not dispute the fact

that the petitioner has joined investigation and further submits that his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.04.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall join investigation, as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
