This petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Sudhir Kumar-petitioner seeking direction to respondents No.2 to 6 to comply with the provisions contained in Section 160 Cr.P.C. i.e. by giving notices in advance, in case petitioner is required in any case by the respondents.

The official respondents have filed reply to the petition specifically mentioning that neither petitioner is named in complaint nor any inquiry is being conducted against him. Rather, inquiry is being conducted by Economic Offences Wing on the basis of a complaint filed by Amrit Pal Singh against some other persons including, father of the petitioner. It has further been mentioned that petitioner was neither harassed nor ever called by the official respondents.
