This is a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Mr. Jashan Preret Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab on behalf of the State, on the instructions of H.C. Om Parkash, informs that the cancellation report has been prepared in this case.

Learned counsel for the complainant has appeared and stated that the matter has been compromised and the complainant is also present in the Court.

I have taken into consideration all the facts and circumstances of the case. The statements of the parties regarding matter having been

compromised could not be recorded before the trial Court on the date fixed.

Taking into consideration the fact that the complainant accepts that the matter has been compromised, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction that the prosecution agency shall finalize the cancellation report stated to have been prepared within a period of one month and present the same before the Court of Illaqua Magistrate with information to the complainant. In case, the complainant appears before the Illaqua Magistrate and makes a statement, after being identified by the Investigating Officer, the trial Court shall record her statement and accept the cancellation report.
