**SABINA, J**

Respondents No.1 to 8 had faced trial in a FIR No.521 dated 03.10.2009, under Sections 342, 447, 427, 506, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short), registered at Police Station City Thanesar.

Trial Court vide order dated 07.10.2011 ordered the acquittal of the respondents No.1 to 8. The said order was upheld in appeal by the Appellate Court vide order dated 10.04.2013. Hence, the present petition by the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record available on the file carefully.

Prosecution story, in brief, is that on 19.04.2009 and 20.04.2009, accused had entered the house of the complainant and had beaten the entire family of the complainant and had threatened to kill them. The accused had also dismantled the gate.

The Courts below while ordering the acquittal of the accused have noticed that there was civil litigation pending between the parties. Hence, it was probable that accused had been falsely involved in this case. The occurrence had allegedly taken place on 19.04.2009 and 20.04.2009, whereas, the application was moved to the police on 21.05.2009. The delay in approaching the police remained unexplained.

In the facts and circumstances of the present case, the Courts below had thus, rightly ordered the acquittal of respondents No.1 to 8.

No ground for interference by this Court, is made out.

Dismissed.
