Class, Jalandhar has been received whereby based on the statements of complainant Kranti and accused Chetan Lal @ Billa, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure matrimonial dispute together with the fact that this compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences between the parties for the betterment of their future lives, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.50 dated 17.07.2014 registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Jalandhar City under Section 498-A IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
