Chand Ram @ Amar Chand (petitioner No.1) is the father of Jagtar Ram (petitioner No.2) and father-in-law of the complainant/respondent No.2- Manjinder Kaur.

Due to the matrimonial dispute between the complainant/wife and the NRI husband/petitioner No.2, FIR No.43 dated 17.07.2011, under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Mukandpur, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar (**Annexure P-1**).

After completion of the investigation, the challan was presented, however, due to absence of the NRI husband, order dated 21.05.2012 (**Annexure P-3**) was passed declaring him as a proclaimed offender.

The present petition has been filed by the father-in-law and the husband of the complainant seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of alleged compromise,

and in the alternative quashing of the order (P-3) declaring the husband as proclaimed offender.

The parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the learned Illaqa Magistrate in terms of the compromise, however, due to the complainant resiling from her stand, no such compromise has been effected.

This Court, vide order date 20.08.2015, had directed petitioner No.2 to surrender before the learned trial Court and secure interim bail to face trial, as he is come back from Italy.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.2 has since been granted interim bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

The interim bail granted to petitioner No.2, vide order dated 20.08.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Disposed of.
