The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.218 dated 25.06.2014, registered under Section 302 IPC, Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

Deceased Seema was married to the petitioner about 9 years ago. She died of electrocution in the matrimonial home on 23.10.2014. The petitioner was arrested and challaned. Charge has been framed. The complainant has been examined. She has not supported the prosecution version.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that both the independent witness namely Anil and Vinod had merely identified the dead body and there is no private witness.

The case is stated to be fixed on 30.05.2015. The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
