Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in complaint case No.3/15, under Sections 188, 272, 273, 284 of the Indian Penal Code along with Section 27 read with Section 18(A) and (C) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940 and Section 4 of COPTA Act, pending for 08.04.2015 in the Court of Sh. A.K.Sharma, Additional Sessions Judge, Panchkula.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the

petitioner could not appear in Court on 24.02.2015 as wrong date has been noted down by the petitioner. His arrest warrants have been issued.

Earlier, FIR No.36 dated 10.03.2012 was registered against the petitioner, however, it transpired that FIR would not lie because the offences were non-cognizable and only complaint would lie. Thereafter, the Court proceeded with the matter treating the FIR as complaint and the petitioner was summoned. In pursuance thereof, the petitioner put his appearance in the Court. However, he could not appear in Court on 24.02.2015 when one PW namely Jagpal Singh was present. The petitioner has remained absent on 24.02.2015 for the first time. His arrest warrants have been issued. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on or before the date fixed which is stated to be 08.04.2015. In case, the petitioner appears before the trial Court, he would be released on bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
