The present petition has been preferred by Sukhjinder Kaur-petitioner, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of her arrest, in case bearing FIR No. 200, dated 15.12.2014, under Sections 379/295-A/506/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It is an undisputed fact that petitioner as well as complainant are members of Shromani Akali Dal and were stakeholders for the post of District President, SC Wing. The complainant, who was appointed as District President has

subsequently, got registered the instant case.

As per the instructions from ASI Pritam Singh, learned State counsel has submitted that petitioner has already joined the investigation on February 05, 2015 and is no more required for further investigation. Even otherwise, the case is triable by the Magistrate. The father-in-law of petitioner has already been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail whereas the husband has been released on regular bail by the Id. Magistrate. In the facts and circumstances of the case, no recovery of article is to be effected from the petitioner.

So, taking into consideration all these aspects of the case, order dated January 06, 2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
