Petitioner, by way of instant petition filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.), seeks quashing of order dated 23.02.2015 (Annexure P-2), passed by learned Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran whereby warrants against petitioner were issued because of his non-appearance before the learned Appellate Court during the pendency of the appeal. While issuing notice of motion vide order dated 20.03.2015, petitioner was directed to appear before Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran on or before the date fixed i.e. 27.03.2015. It was further directed that on appearance of the petitioner, he shall be admitted to interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran.

In view of the above, no further orders are warranted in the present case. In case the petitioner has already appeared, he must have been admitted to interim bail and the same shall be confirmed and will operate during the pendency of the appeal. If

petitioner has not appeared so far, he shall appear and on his appearance, the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran shall admit the petitioner to bail during the pendency of the appeal.

With the above said observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
