Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.257 dated 21.09.2014, under Sections 148/149/323/427/307/452 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 324 IPC and Section 54, 59 of Arms Act added later on), registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 20.03.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the

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satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from the investigating officer, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 20.03.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
