Report dated 18.6.2014 sent by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fazilka has been received, whereby, after recording the statements of the parties it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Since the parties are closely related to each other and the allegations against the accused are not of very serious nature, thus, to facilitate harmony and to bring about cordial relations and that the compromise will go a long way assuaging the feelings of wrong done and would remove all ill-will and hatred between the parties, FIR No.143 dated 06.11.2007 under Sections 420,467,465,468,471 and 120-B IPC Police Station City Fazilka, District Ferozepur and all other consequential proceedings

arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
