RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and have performed marriage on 17.03.2015 at Gurudwara Sh. Kalgidhar Singh Sabha (Regd.) Kotli Road, Muktsar (Punjab.) The photographs of marriage have been annexed as (Annexure P-3) along with marriage certificate as (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel further submitted that the petitioners have moved a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar

(Annexure P-5) but no action has been taken so far.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation made by the petitioners (Annexure P-5) and if required, necessary protection be provided to them if they are not required in any unlawful activity.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
