Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioners, who were appointed on the post of Hindi Guest Teachers on contract basis w.e.f. 20.10.2006, have approached this Court with a prayer that they be not relieved from the duty on account of the fact that they had passed B.Ed. from Hindi Sahitya Sammelan, Allahabad.

Considering the facts mentioned in the reply filed by the State, there is no merit in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the State, while referring to a Division Bench judgment of this Court in CWP No.16320 of 1996, titled as 'Ram Bhagat Sharma and others vs. State of Haryana and others' decided on 16.05.1997 has submitted that in this judgment, it was held that the Hindi Sahitya Sammelan, Allahabad is a fake institution, being run in single room. Hence, its qualification cannot be said to be recognized. It was not established under an Act of the Parliament or of the State Legislature nor it has been recognized by the Kurukshetra University or Maharishi Dayanand University. The petitioners appointed as Guest Teachers on contract basis have been relieved from services as they were not qualified for the said posts.

The writ petition is dismissed.
