FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 15.5.2015 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Pankaj Chhabra and Nirmal Chhabra as well as of complainant Ritu Arora it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there was purely a matrimonial dispute between the parties which has now been settled by way of compromise and that this compromise will go a long way to settle the future life of the couple and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.104 dated 16.12.2009 under Sections 498-A, 406, 494 IPC Police Station, D-Division, District Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
