Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to complete investigation in FIR No.1188 dated 16.11.2006, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station DLF, Gurgaon.

Heard.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the latest status report. Paras 6 and 7 of the said report read as under:-

“That now, the DGP Crime, Haryana, Panchkula has made a request vide his letter no.16440/CR-4 dated 20.11.2015 to the Addl. Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Home Department, Chandigarh by enclosing the memo no.47802 dated 05.11.2015 and 26323/JCP dated 19.10.2011 of the Commissioner of Police, Gurgaon, to forward the letter rogatory to the Under Secretary (Legal), Internal Security Division, Ministry of Home Affairs, Lok Nayak Bhawan, New Delhi for taking necessary action regarding the

extradition proceedings of accused Anna Tkacheva from Russia. The matter is being perused with the above said office to get the same expedite.

That the status report of the proceedings of extradition being undertaken by the Gurgaon Police has been submitted in the court of Ld. JMIC, Gurgaon on 27.02.2015, 21.03.2015, 18.04.2015, 17.08.2015, 07.10.2015 and 16.11.2015 to apprise the said court regarding the latest steps being taken by the police to proceed in the matter of extradition of accused Anna Tkacheva. The copies of reports are annexed as Annexure R-1 to R-6. On dated 03.06.2015, SI Virender Singh, Addl. SHO P.S. DLF Sector-29, Gurgaon verbally apprised the court of Ld. JMIC, Gurgaon of the status of extradition proceedings."

In view of the latest status report submitted by the learned counsel for the State, no ground for interference by this Court, at this stage, is called for.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

However, personal appearance of the petitioner, before the trial Court, shall remain exempted till the investigation in the present case is completed, subject to the following conditions:-

- i. Petitioner shall be represented through counsel;
- ii. shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the Trial Court;
