Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.80 dated 08.09.2013, registered at Police Station Shapurkandi, District Pathankot, under Sections 3/4/5 of Immoral Traffic (Prev.) Act, 1956 (SIT Act, Renamed).

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner that he is running a brothel house and destroying the lives of innocent girls. To unearth the racket wherein innocent girls are being exploited, custodial
