The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuance of a direction to respondents no.1 to 3 for protecting life and liberty of the petitioner. The petitioner has already moved representation dated 02.02.2015 (Annexure P-1) to respondent no.2- Inspector General of Police, Patiala Zone, Patiala.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Inspector General of Police, Patiala Zone, Patiala and respondent no.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, to personally look into the grievance of the petitioner as narrated in representation (Annexure P-1)

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and if facts are found to be correct, then necessary protection shall be provided to the petitioner in accordance with law.
