Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the date of marriage though not specifically pleaded in the petition, but the petitioners solemnized marriage on 1.3.2015 in Gurudwara Sixth Patshahi, Fatehgarh Sahib. In this marriage, it is alleged that parents of petitioner No.2 were present, however, parents of petitioner No.1 were averse to the matrimonial tie of the petitioners. Petitioners feel reasonable apprehension at the hands of parents of petitioner No.1. Precisely for this a complaint was moved by petitioner No.1 against her parents and brother in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Fatehgarh Sahib and the said complaint is statedly pending and is fixed for 30.3.2015. In view of

aforesaid, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and if need be, provide necessary protection to the petitioners, if they are not involved any other offence.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
