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TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Appeal No.366 of 2011 titled as Didar Singh Vs. Punjab Urban Planning and Development Authority arising out of complaint No.120 dated 16.08.2003, under Section 36 of the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995.

On 23.03.2015, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:

“The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking protection against arrest in Appeal No.366 of 2011 arising out of complaint No.120 dated 16.8.2003 under section 36 of the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995.

Counsel would contend that there were three connected appeals which have been taken up together and in which the present petitioner had been duly appearing. However, in Appeal No.366 of 2011 in which non-bailable warrants have been issued, the same had been segregated subsequently and it

is only for that reason that the petitioner had not appeared.

Notice of motion, returnable for 30.4.2015.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Trial Court on the date already fixed i.e. 30.3.2015.

*In the eventuality of the petitioner doing so, he would be entitled to **ad interim** protection subject to satisfaction of the Trial Court.”*

During the course of hearing today, it has gone un-rebutted that the present petitioner has duly appeared before the trial Court and upon furnishing requisite bail bonds has been granted the benefit of ad interim bail.

Under such circumstances, wherein the petitioner has joined the process of law, prayer is allowed.

Order dated 23.03.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
