MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for bail in terms thereof in case FIR No.19 dated 7.1.2015 under Sections 186, 332, 353, 307, 364 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Gurgaon Sadar, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioners had contended that the allegations against the petitioners are seemingly false. The family of the petitioners is running an eatery where the complainant-Constable after having meals was asked to pay which became a cause of grievance to them. They implicated Manish, younger son of the family, who eventually committed suicide. The said policemen are facing proceedings on account of the allegations against them and the present FIR is an attempt to

falsely implicate the petitioners on account of these facts.

Noticing the aforesaid, interim protection was granted to the petitioners on 23.3.2015 subject to their complying with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. pursuant to which they have since joined the investigation which fact is not controverted by the learned counsel for the State on instructions from SI Dharambir Singh.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 23.3.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition allowed.
