Instant revision petitions have been filed by the petitioners for quashing of order dated 05.07.2013 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Jhajjar, whereby they had been summoned under Section 319 of Code of Criminal Procedure.

The brief facts of the case are that Dharambir lodged an FIR No.215 dated 22.06.2010 under Sections 148, 149, 302, 307, 449, 120-B/216 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station City, Bahadurgarh with the allegation that he saw Devinder, Rambir, Naresh @ Nesi, Ashok, Mukesh and Karambir @ Chhota leaving the hospital after killing his son Rakesh @ Kala and the whole occurrence has taken at the behest of Takdir and his relatives (present petitioners) due to election rivalry.

By virtue of this common order, this Court intends to dispose of three revision petitions bearing CRR-2525-2013, CRR-2666-2013 and CRR-2917-2013, whereby the petitioner(s) has challenged the order dated July 05, 2013 vide which they have been summoned to stand trial as additional accused(s) under Section 302 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC in case FIR No.215 dated 22.06.2010 registered at Police Station City, Bahadurgarh.

In compliance of the order dated July 24, 2015, Mr. Akshat Prasher, ASD Lab, High Court, Chandigarh, has played the CD of CCTV footage of the hospital where an occurrence has been taken place. The same has been closely watched by undersigned as well as respective counsel for the parties and the State counsel.

During hearing, it came to light that trial is at penultimate and the petitioners are already appearing/facing the same. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) in all the three revision petitions bearing CRR-2525-2013, CRR-2666-2013 and CRR-2917-2013 has submitted that revision petitions be disposed of with liberty to take all the pleas taken in the respective revision petitions by them before the trial Court at the time of arguments/trial etc.

With the aforesaid liberty, petitions stand disposed of.
