Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.889 dated 11.11.2014, under Sections 420, 468, 471, 472 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal, District Karnal.

This Court vide order dated 1.4.2015, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner and vide order dated 10.7.2015, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Ram Avtar, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined

investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 1.4.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
