There are allegations of kidnapping for ransom by Akash, Parveen, Sonu, Jitender, Subhash and the present petitioner. Akash was declared a juvenile, while Parveen was declared as proclaimed offender. The other three persons besides the petitioner are in custody.

Two witnesses namely Goga and Kuldeep were examined.

In view of the allegations in the FIR and the fact that the petitioner, if released on bail, is likely to tamper with the evidence or may try to win over the witnesses, no ground for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
