Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to petitioner
Megh Raj (father-in-law) in FIR No.111 dated 17.8.2012 under Sections
498-A/120-B IPC, later on added 304-B IPC registered at Police Station
Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Lakhbir
Singh, states that as against 9 prosecution witnesses cited by the prosecution,
8 witnesses have already been examined and the case is now fixed on

20.7.2015 for recording the statement of remaining prosecution witness.

In view of the fact that the trial is at fag end of its conclusion, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of this petition at this stage but states that the trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and to conclude the same within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
