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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.71 dated 22.08.2014, registered under Sections 376, 384, 506, 411, 354-A, 354-D IPC, Section 8 and 12 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act and Section 67 of I.T. Act, Police Station Division No.1, Pathankot, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 24.03.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court and was released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gulshan Kumar has stated that the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court and was granted interim bail.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 24.03.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
