Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 452, 323, 341, 384, 506, 148, 149 IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 147, dated 23.09.2014, registered at Police Station, Sadar, District-Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 23.03.2015, this Court has directed the petitioner to join investigation subject to terms and conditions, as envisaged by under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Raghbir Singh, very fairly states that in compliance of the interim directions issued by this Court, vide order dated 23.03.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court, vide order dated 23.03.2015, are made absolute.

However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
