The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.151 dated 02.07.2013 for offence under Sections 323/324/452/506/34 (326 added later) of Indian Penal Code (IPC), registered at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal, based on compromise.

Report from the trial Court has been received after recording statements of parties, in a sealed envelope containing original statements of the parties and which be opened and taken on record. It is reported that compromise is voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Reply by way of affidavit of Rajesh Kumar, HPS, Dy. Superintendent of Police, (HQ), Karnal has been filed by learned State counsel and the same be taken on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Shrikant submits that the petitioner is the only accused in this FIR and respondent No.2 is the only aggrieved person.

No useful purpose would be served in continuing with the proceedings in this case in view of the compromise arrived at between them.

Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgement of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052 (P&H)*** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others, (2012)10 SCC 303***, this petition is allowed and FIR No.151 dated 02.07.2013 for offence under Sections 323/324/452/506/34 (326 added later) of Indian Penal Code (IPC), registered at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal and the subsequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof, are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements.
