MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 34 dated 7.3.2013 registered under Section 379, 411 IPC and Section 21 of Mines Act at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

The petitioner had absented himself during the trial and was declared a proclaimed offender but surrendered before the Trial Court on 26.2.2015 whereafter he is in custody.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that since the petitioner is in custody since February, 2015 and trial is in progress, he deserves the concession of bail.

On due consideration of the matter and noticing the period of custody of the petitioner and the fact that the trial may take some time, instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C. Trial Court while accepting his bail bonds shall ensure heavy surety so as to obviate the chances of any future default. Bail to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
