Report dated 1.4.2015 sent by learned SDJM, Guruhar Sahai has been received, whereby, after recording statements of the petitioners Gurwinder Singh, Balwinder Singh, Kashmir Singh and Gurcharan Singh as well as of complainant Jasbir Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that offences are not heinous in nature and the parties belong to the same very area and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the difference between the parties and to remove hatred and ill-will and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.94 dated 9.12.2013 under Sections 324 and 34 IPC Police Station, Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
