ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.27 dated 21.03.2014, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC, Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 07.04.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated. He further states that compromise has been effected between the parties.

Power of attorney on behalf of complainant filed. Counsel for the complainant also confirms the factum of compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 07.04.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
