The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.216 dated 04.06.2014, registered under Sections 302, 201 of IPC and 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar during the pendency of the trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated whereas no offence is made out against him. The complainant and husband of the deceased have not supported the case of the prosecution.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Jitender submits that the date fixed before the trial Court is 31.01.2014 and out of total 27 witnesses, 10 witnesses have

already been examined and the remaining witnesses are likely to be examined on the next date fixed before the trial Court.

After hearing the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the stage of the trial, no ground is made out to grant regular bail to the petitioner. The petition is, therefore, dismissed.

However, keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner, the trial Court is directed to make all efforts to conclude the trial within a period of three months.
