JASPAL SINGH, J.

The present petition has been preferred by Amarjit Singh-
petitioner, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for
grant of pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case
bearing FIR No. 174, dated 06.12.2014, under Section 420 IPC,
registered at Police Station City SBS Nagar.

On instructions from ASI Darbara Singh, learned State
counsel has submitted that petitioner has already joined the
investigation on 02.05.2015 and is no more required for further
investigation.

So, taking into consideration all these aspects of the case, order dated March 23, 2015, is made absolute, subject to the following conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C:

- (i) a condition that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) a condition that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) a condition that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.*
