1. The present petition has been filed by petitioner Inderjit Singh under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of the anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 39 dated 17.02.2015, under Sections 326, 324, 120-B, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

2. The status report filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Balwinder Singh Sekhon, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City) Ferozepur. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. On 05.05.2015, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in

the medico legal report the injury attributed to the present petitioner has been mentioned as small lacerated wound. But, at the other place this injury has been shown to be grievous. There seems to be some ambiguity about the nature of the injury.

Learned State counsel seeks time to clarify the position.

He is directed to file the affidavit of the Gazetted police official after verifying the nature of injury no. 2 on the person of complainant Rakesh Kumar.

Adjourned to 07.07.2015.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he will be admitted to the interim anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer on the conditions that he will join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer, that he will not directly or indirectly tamper with the prosecution evidence and that he will not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.”

4. As per the status report, the injury no.2 on the person of complainant Rakesh Kumar attributed to the present petitioner is simple in nature.

5. Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Baljinder Singh, Police Station City Ferozepur has stated at bar that the petitioner has already joined the investigation

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and is not required for any custodial interrogation.

6. Thus, the present petition is hereby allowed and the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 05.05.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
